

Modi to speak with beneficiaries today to boost vaccine confidence

NEW DELHI, JANUARY 21

WITH NEARLY one million health workers getting the first dose of the Covid-19 vaccine, Prime Minister Narendra Modi will Friday speak with some of these beneficiaries on their inoculation experience in order to boost confidence among the people.

"The world's largest vaccination drive is underway in India. Our frontline warriors are getting vaccinated across the nation. At 1:15 PM tomorrow, 22nd January, I would interact with beneficiaries and vaccinators of Covid vaccination drive in Varanasi, via video conferencing," Prime Minister Modi tweeted.

Sources in the PMO indicated that as another step towards creating vaccine confidence, the Prime Minister and other elected representatives will likely take the vaccine in the second phase, when the priority group above the age of 50 will be inoculated. "The PM also is likely to take the vaccine. In the first phase, it was meant for health workers and frontline workers. Now, it will not be out of turn for political leaders," said a source.

Thursday said the cumulative number of vaccinated health-care workers had touched 9,99,065 till 6 pm.

The Prime Minister said the virtual interaction "would give first-hand opportunity to hear their experiences as well as feedback" on vaccination.

"The interaction follows continuous dialogue and discussion by the Prime Minister with scientists, political leaders, officials and other stakeholders to proactively ensure smooth conduct of the world's largest vaccination drive," the Prime Minister's Office said in a statement.

On the demand by several states, including BJP-ruled Bihar, that elected representatives be included in the first priority group, Modi during his interaction with Chief Ministers had earlier said: "... This is my personal suggestion. First are the corona warriors, second are frontline workers. The people's representatives are not included in this category."

The Health Ministry said that on Thursday, 4,041 vaccination sessions were conducted across the country and 1,92,581 beneficiaries were vaccinated till 6 pm. "187 Adverse Events Following Immunization (AEFIs) have been reported till 6 pm on

Thursday, Odisha (26,558), Telangana (26,441), Karnataka (16,103) and Bihar (15,798) recorded the maximum vaccinations in the country. The Health Ministry said one hospitalisation following immunisation has been reported from Rajasthan—however, the event was "not related to vaccination". The beneficiary was vaccinated on January 16 and four days later suffered from intracranial hemorrhage and was admitted to an Udaipur hospital.

FIRE AT SERUM INSTITUTE

BCG, Rotavirus vaccine, too many products damaged; victims' families to get Rs 25 lakh

SERUM INSTITUTE OF India (SII) CEO Adar Poonawalla, who is not in the country at present, expressed shock over the fire mishap at the institute's building on Thursday that claimed five lives. "Not in a mood to speak. BCG, Rotavirus vaccine, too many products have been damaged in the fire," Poonawalla told *The Indian Express*.

The mishap took place at one of the under-construction buildings at the Special Economic Zone at SII's Manjri plant on Thursday afternoon. Poonawalla, who said a few floors of the building have destroyed in the fire, took to Twitter to reassure all governments and common people that the mishap would not affect the production of Covishield, a vaccine for Covid-19, as multiple buildings had been kept reserved to deal with such contingencies at SII.

"This was a new building at the Special Economic Zone campus at Manjri. It was on the verge of completion and the facility was built to manufacture extra quantities of BCG and Rotavirus vaccines. We do not know the cause of the fire and will assess the extent of the damage soon," Dr Cyrus Poonawalla, chairman

and managing director, SII, who was at the facility told *The Indian Express*.

"You cannot imagine the shock and human tragedy that have happened here apart from the huge losses. We are all shaken," Dr Rajeev Dhere, executive director at SII, who was with Dr Poonawalla, said.

SII is the world's largest vaccine manufacturer in terms of number of doses produced and sold globally (more than 1.5 billion doses). The institute manufactures vaccine doses for polio, diphtheria, tetanus and pertussis among others. It is estimated that about 65 per cent of the children in the world receive at least one vaccine manufactured by SII. With the licensure of additional facilities, SII has the flexibility to produce vaccines in more than one plant and facilitate the production of a large number of doses in the shortest time frame.

The Manjri plant is 3km from the institute's main plant at Hadapsar where Covishield is being manufactured. The building where the fire broke out is close to Adar Poonawalla's new office and boardroom. The office is inside a refurbished plane and is inside a building named Terminal 1. Poonawalla converted an Airbus A320 into an office space.

Informed sources said Prime Minister Narendra Modi had vis-

ited the building at the Manjri plant on November 28. The Prime Minister interacted with the manufacturer team about the making, logistics and distribution of Covishield vaccine.

Dr Poonawalla told *The Indian Express* that the compensation of Rs 25 lakh to each of the families of the fire victims, in addition to the mandated amount as per the norm. A statement later was issued on Facebook and Twitter where the SII chairman and managing director

said: "Today is an extremely sorrowful day for all of us at Serum Institute of India. Regrettably there were losses of lives in the fire that broke out in our under installation facility at the Special Economic Zone at Manjri."

Army Havildar killed in Pak firing in Poonch

AN ARMY Havildar was killed on Thursday after Pakistani troops resorted to unprovoked cease-fire violation along the Line of Control in Jammu and Kashmir's Krishna Ghati sector of Poonch district.

Identifying the soldier as Havildar Nirmal Singh of 10 Jammu and Kashmir Rifles, an Udhampur-based Army PRO said he was critically injured and later succumbed to his injuries. Indian troops had responded "strongly" to the enemy fire, he added.

Havildar Nirmal Singh was a brave, highly motivated and a sincere soldier, he said, adding that the nation will always remain indebted to him for his supreme sacrifice and devotion to duty.

V K Sasikala tests positive for Covid

V K SASIKALA, the close aide of late Jayalalitha, tested positive for the Covid-19 on Thursday night. Ahead of her release from the Bangalore Parappana Agrahara Central prison on January 27, where she was a convict in a disproportionate assets case, Sasikala was taken to Bowring Hospital Wednesday after she complained of breathlessness.

Following her family's request, she was shifted to Victoria Hospital on Thursday. She was being treated in the ICU for Severe Acute Respiratory Infection. Earlier, Sasikala tested negative for Covid-19 twice.

Sources close to her family said some family members were allowed to visit her and that her

condition is stable. A medical bulletin from Victoria Hospital on Thursday evening, before the Covid-19 test result came in, said she was being treated for Severe Acute Respiratory Illness with antibiotics, an antiviral, besides insulin, steroids and other supportive measures.

Sasikala was reportedly unwell at her prison cell for about a week and she was shifted to hospital after she developed a high temperature and complained of breathlessness. Authorities agreed to shift her to Victoria Hospital after the family complained of delay in conducting a CT scan of the chest. The scan facility was reportedly not available at the government hospital where she was initially admitted. Her close relatives, including her nephew T T V Dhinakaran and Dr Sivakumar, are camping at Bengaluru.
